These two events are not only a lot of fun, but are crucial to creating a great experience for the hunters. *We ask that if you are not able to commit to attending both of these events, you consider reapplying as a guide next year.* While we cannot prohibit you from hunting on April 21, if you harvest a turkey during the One Shot Hunt, it will not be scored as part of this event.
